Entries close Friday, May 19.

- Dogs who pass the stake on the first day will be allowed to move up to the next higher stake on the second day if they so desire (and if they have entered both days).
- Dogs may not be entered in more than one stake on the same day.
- Day of test entries will not be accepted.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to run the test.

“A dog must be registered with the American Kennel Club and documentation of AKC registration must be on file with Records to be eligible for Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) titles.”

Refunds:

Full refunds for scratches reported in writing prior to the drawing. After May 26, 2017, a \$25.00 scratch fee will be charged except for bitches in season or injured dogs when the scratch is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. No refunds will be given after the start of the test.

CHECK-IN FOR TESTS WILL BEGIN AT 8:00 AM

Running order will be determined by random draw after closing.

- NSDTRC-USA ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying dogs.
- Ducks will be used on land and water.
- No training is allowed on test grounds on day of test or 24 hours prior. Exercise/airing areas will be available.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the test grounds.

Box lunches available for pre-order

The club will be making box lunches available on a pre-order basis for \$12 each. Please indicate on the entry form if you would like to order a box lunch. Information on lunch selection and payment will be emailed to you separately after your entry has been received.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

Breummer's Ranch, Port of Dewatto, WA 98588

DIRECTIONS from I-5 in Tacoma via Highway 16:

- A map with instructions is available on the Club website www.pugetsoundretrieverclub.com
- Through Tacoma on I-5 (near Tacoma Dome) exit onto WA-16 West. Continue on WA-16 West approximately 26 mi toward Bremerton (you will cross the Tacoma Narrows Bridge). When you see the water inlet on the right you'll be approaching the Gorst area (Landmark is bright red Mattress Ranch on the right).
- From Gorst, take **LEFT** hand exit #28 for Hwy 3 SOUTH towards Belfair / Shelton. Turn **LEFT** onto Hwy 3 West at the signal. Continue approx 8 miles to town of Belfair.
- Watch for Starbucks & Safeway on the right, then turn **RIGHT** at the signal onto NE Old Clifton Road. (Last stop for coffee & goodies!)
- Go 0.2 miles to a 4-way stop. Turn **RIGHT** onto NE Old Belfair Hwy.
- Go 3.4 miles then turn **LEFT** onto Bear Creek/Dewatto Road.
- Continue 10.4 miles on Bear Creek Dewatto Rd to stop sign (road becomes narrow and winding).
- Turn left onto Dewatto Holly Road. Travel approximately 3 miles to the land test site on the **LEFT**.
- Watch for Dog Event Signage!

Notes for completing the entry form:

NSDTRC-USA field test rules allow for a dog who has entered both days to do the following:

- A dog **MUST** have entered and paid for both days before the test closing date in order to run both days.
- If the dog does not pass the entered stake on day 1, they are allowed to run the same stake again on day 2.
- If the dog has passed the entered stake on day 1, they are allowed to move up to the next higher stake on day 2.
- If the dog has passed the entered stake on day 1, they may still run again in the same stake on day 2, though for the purposes of titling only the initial pass will be recorded.

Example: You submit your entry for your dog to run the WC on both Saturday and Sunday. Your dog passes the WC on Saturday. You will then be allowed to move up and run the WCI on Sunday if you so desire. Or, you may still run the WC a second time on Sunday.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the Rules and Regulations of the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree that the club holding this test, Puget Sound Retriever Club (PSRC), has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In considerations of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, and/or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or Test Secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or ground or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this test, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.
